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26	The River Heights City Planning Commission met at 7:00 p.m. in the Ervin R. Crosbie

29	Adoption of Prior Minutes: Minutes for the October 1, 2013 Planning Commission		
30	Meeting were reviewed.		
31	Commissioner Petersen moved to "approve the minutes of the October 1, 2013		
32	Commission meeting." Commissioner Seeholzer seconded the motion, which carried.		
33	Discuss Code Changes: Councilmember Wright reviewed the proposed changes to the		
34	City Code of River Heights City. The underlined or crossed out words are the proposed changes		
35	to the code. See attached Proposed Changes To The City Code of River Heights City, Utah. He		
36	requested that 7. Title 10 Chapter 13 Section 24 have a N added stating that nothing is to be		
37	placed in the dumpster enclosure except the dumpster. He will have the engineer, Craig		
38	Rasmussen, update the dumpster drawings to state such. The Standard Drawing: Single Bin		

Solid Waste Enclosure drawing has been updated by the engineer showing where a curb will beon the dumpster enclosure

On 8. Title 10 Chapter 13 Section 25 E. Councilmember Wright recommended adding
the verbiage to read; "In order to provide collection on a private road, the property owner must
sign a waiver stating that Logan City won't be liable for road damage."

44 Discuss Possible Sidewalk Ordinance Changes: In Ordinance 2-2005, River Heights City Sidewalk Ordinance, it states that when a sidewalk is replaced the City pays 50% and the 45 homeowner pays 50%. Councilmember Wright recommended that if it is a project that the city 46 47 chooses to take on, it is up to the City to determine if they will have the homeowner pay half or not. If it is tree roots, then it is caused by the homeowner planting trees so they should be 48 included in the cost. Mayor Baker suggested to add "at the option of the City Council, this fee 49 could be waived". Councilmember Wright will add at the end of the second sentence of the 50 3rd paragraph to read; "Modifications to this policy will be at the sole discretion of the City 51 Council", and bring this addition to the next City Council meeting. 52 53 Discuss ADA Language to Add to the General Plan: Councilmember Wright asked Commissioner Royle to assign someone to work with Councilmember Okelberry regarding the 54 ADA language to add to the General Plan stating that the City wants to be ADA compliant. He 55 56 stated that it should not identify a schedule or a financial requirement, but that it could include Mr. Okelberry's drawing. Commissioner Royle assigned himself. This item will be on the next 57 agenda. Mr. Wright will ask Wendy Wilker to have the changes to the above ordinances be 58 advertised for a public hearing on November 5. 59 60 The meeting adjourned at 8:10 p.m.
