<p>I hereby certify that I have read and examined this application and know the same to be true and correct. All provisions of laws and ordinances governing this type of work shall be complied with, whether specified herein or not, the granting of this permit does not presume to give authority to violate or cancel the provisions of any other state or local law regulating construction or the performance of construction.</p> <p>I understand that this Stormwater Permit is required and will remain in effect until the entire project is stabilized and the Notice of Termination (NOT) has been submitted for those that have an NOI. All control measures must be inspected weekly. Any tracking of debris onto the road must be cleaned within a reasonable time frame as needed. Records of all inspections, changes to the site plan and failures of control devices will be kept. The Permittee is required to train all subcontractors, vendors, delivery personnel, and others who will be working on the site as to the requirements of this permit. The Permittee is responsible for compliance of all required permits for the entire site throughout the duration of the project. I understand that a pre-construction inspection will be required before any work can commence.</p>
