

Ordinance 5-2026

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT CHANGES TO THE CITY CODE OF RIVER HEIGHTS, UTAH

Wherefore, the River Heights City Planning Commission held a duly noticed public hearing on Tuesday, May 12, 2026, and

Wherefore, the River Heights City Council adopted the changes suggested by the Planning Commission on May 19, 2026, and

Wherefore, the River Heights City Council made an additional change to the Sign Ordinance as follows;

10-16-5: POLITICAL SIGNAGE

- A. Location: May be placed only on private property with permission of the property owner.
- ~~B. Timeframe: For ninety (90) days preceding a primary, general or special election, temporary signs may be placed on any one parcel of property. Signs need to be removed within one week after a general or special election.~~
- C. B. Size: There are no size restrictions on political signs if the sign(s) do not obstruct protected sight triangles (10-13-15) or otherwise cause unsafe conditions.

Therefore, the River Heights City Council adopted the preceding changes to the River Heights City Code to become effective this 16th day of June 2026.
